#### Message From Our President

This year has been a fantastic year for The Executives. Through the end of October, we've already raised over \$640,000. Beginning in early 2015, we created the Generation to Generation (G2G) Society which has had rapid growth, and has become a premier philanthropic venue for Valley-based donors who each contribute \$5,000 or more annually to the Los Angeles Jewish Home through The Executives.

Our fundraising events have been an enormous success. The 11th Annual Poker Tournament took place in March at Braemar Country Club with close to 100 attendees and raised approximately \$30,000 for the seniors of the Home. In May, The Executives honored Leon Blankstein at the 18th Annual Circle of Life Gala at the Skirball Cultural Center, and Brandon Matloff received the Jack Schlaifer Young Executive Award. Over \$250,000 was raised at this event, our largest annual fundraiser for the Home. The 12th Annual Golf Classic took place in October at the beautiful Angeles National Golf Club, raising over \$85,000 with 72 attendees.

For 2016, we are forging ahead with new inclusive membership packages (see center insert). The Executives Plus membership for \$500/year or \$42/month includes complimentary attendance to six Breakfast/Evening Speaker Series or Networking Lunch programs of your choice (a \$180 value). We are also working on an industry-focused initiative, reinstating our marketing/communications committee, and developing plans for evening and lunch programs to match our successful December 2014 evening with Consul General of Israel, David Siegel. Additionally, through our work with the Strategic Planning Committee over the past year, we have put ourselves on a path to reach our goal of raising \$1 million a year in 5 years.

Thank you to our Board and Committee members for all your support and hard work. None of what we have accomplished this past year could have happened without you. I look forward to the year ahead.

The early morning chill did nothing to deter Executives members who came out at 7a.m. on a Sunday morning in their down parkas and mittens to insure that Walk of Ages XVI would be just as successful as it had been over the last fifteen years. As the sun began to shine and warm things up a bit, The Executives team joined five hundred and sixty other participants as they all converged on Woodley Park to greet the morning and challenge themselves to a 5 or 10k run/walk in support of the Jewish Home. This year's Walk, held on Sunday, November 15, included, for the first time, a 10k run in addition to the usual 5k run/walk.

The event officially opened with the community of participants converging to the main stage for a Welcome Ceremony led by Walk co-chairs, Executives board member - Stuart Lorch and David Cohan. Councilman Bob Blumenfield gave greetings and shared inspiring and very supportive words about the Jewish Home. A special award was presented to Karl Sussman in gratitude for his years of putting smiles on the faces of kids of all ages as the official clown of the Walk of Ages for most of its fifteen years.

As the welcome remarks concluded, the horn was sounded and 100 runners sprinted out for a chip timed run through the park, followed by another 450

5k runners and walkers. As participants crossed the finish line they were cheered on by Jewish Home residents, local cheerleaders and teen volunteers. Hungry stomachs were filled with a "Home"made pancake breakfast, goodie bags and other treats that were donated by our event sponsors.

The Executives team, led by Michelle Weisman and over twenty members strong, raised \$12,000, which was the most of any support group and any other team at the Walk this year. Go Executives!!

The financial backbone of the event came from our Walk of Ages Championship Sponsors – Harriet & Benjamin D. Bagno. This year the Walk raised \$130,000, a 14% increase over last year. Proceeds from the Walk of Ages support our Jewish Home's seniors in residence and in the community.

#### Connections to Care

A Program of the Los Angeles Jewish Home (855) 227-3745

**ONE CALL DOES IT ALL** is the driving force behind Connections to Care, an innovative approach to meeting seniors' diverse and complex healthcare needs. A single phone call to (855) 227-3745 connects directly to the Los Angeles Jewish Home's expert professional staff to access our award-winning in-home, community health, and residential programs and services.



#### **In-Home and Community Health Services**

#### **PACE (Program of All-inclusive Care for the Elderly)**

The PACE program enables frail seniors with multiple health conditions to live safely at home. Among the program's many services are adult day healthcare, primary and specialty medical care, vision and dental care, medications, physical, occupational, and speech therapy, transportation, acute care, home health care and caregiving. The program serves patients age 55 and over who live in the Jewish Home's service area.

#### **Home Health Care**

The Home Health Care program offers a full spectrum of restorative services in the individual's home. Clients are referred by a physician's written order and treatments are provided according to a plan of care jointly developed by the referring physician, the person receiving care, the caregiver, and others. Home Health Care services are available to adults over 19 years of age in the Greater Los Angeles area.

#### **Palliative Medicine**

The Palliative Medicine program provides comprehensive pain and symptom management for adults with serious, chronic, and/or life-limiting illness. Our team of professionals addresses the medical, psychological, social, and spiritual needs of our patients.

#### **Care Management**

The Care Management program helps improve the coordination of care following a hospital admission, with the goal of decreasing the risk of readmission within 30 days of discharge.

#### **Geriatric Community Clinic**

The Geriatric Community Clinic is located on the Jewish Home's Eisenberg Village campus in Reseda. The clinic provides primary and specialty medical care to seniors.

#### **Hospice**

The Home's Skirball Hospice provides compassionate end-of-life care for adults with a life-limiting illness in the Greater Los Angeles area. Skirball Hospice treats patients in their home or care facility. Hospice care includes pain management, medical equipment, supplies, and personal care. Our staff members work as an integrated team, including nurses, chaplains, social workers, registered dieticians, and certified home health aides.



#### Short-term Care at the Jewish Home

#### **Transitional Care Unit**

The Transitional Care Unit (TCU) is designed to help seniors successfully recover from an illness, injury, medical procedure, or acute hospital stay. The TCU provides short-term rehabilitative and skilled nursing care. Patients in the TCU receive treatment from physicians and geriatric specialists in physical, occupational, and speech therapy. The average length of stay ranges between two to six weeks. When possible, TCU seniors discharged home may transition with short-term skilled nursing and/or rehabilitative therapies through our home health agency.

#### **Geriatric Psychiatry Unit**

Certified to treat both voluntary and involuntary admissions, the Geriatric Psychiatry Unit provides short-term geriatric psychiatric care to individuals over the age of 55 who are experiencing stressful mental or emotional challenges that require intensive, short-term acute hospital psychiatric care. Most commonly treated diagnoses are depression, bipolar disorders, post-traumatic stress disease (PTSD), schizophrenia, delirium, and Alzheimer's or other age-related dementia with behavioral disturbance. The average length of stay is 10-14 days. The primary care physician is kept informed during the patient's stay, and follow-up appointments are made with the patient's physician as a part of the discharge plan.



#### **Long-term Care at the Jewish Home**

#### **Independent Senior Housing**

Fountainview at Eisenberg Village and the soon-to-open Fountainview at Gonda Westside are each licensed as a continuing care retirement community (CCRC). A CCRC is designed for active independent senior living. CCRC residents have easy access to assisted living services in their units (as needed), as well as priority access to the Home's skilled nursing facilities.

#### **Residential Care**

Seniors in our residential care facilities are over 65 years of age, independently mobile, and mentally alert. Residential care includes meals, medication management, social services, chaplaincy, fitness and recreational activities, transportation, and many educational programs.

#### Alzheimer's Disease and Dementia Special Care Center

Our Special Care Center is among the most advanced of its kind in the world and is designed to provide exceptional skilled nursing care for patients with Alzheimer's disease and age-related dementia.

#### **Skilled Nursing**

Our long-term skilled nursing services play a critical role in stabilizing and improving seniors' health and enhancing their quality of life and sense of well-being.

## Jewish Home Care Services There's No Place Like Home

Did you know the Los Angeles Jewish Home has a home healthcare agency? In 2014, Jewish Home Care Services (JHCS) began providing services to adults who require skilled nursing or rehabilitative care in their homes because of their medical condition. When recovering from a surgery, injury, or accident, home healthcare can be an excellent option to help you get back on your feet in the comfort of your own home.

Home healthcare enables a patient's physician to prescribe and develop an individualized plan of care in coordination with the patient and with JHCS. Services are provided by our multidisciplinary team members, who include a medical director; registered nurse; licensed vocational nurse; certified home health aide; physical, occupational, and speech therapists; a medical social worker; and dietary services.

JHCS offers short-term assistance with personal needs such as bathing or oral care; assesses physical status, functional level, and potential for rehabilitation; provides therapeutic rehabilitative training programs to improve the

patient's ability to carry out activities of daily living; and provides counseling related to the impact of illness and assists with referrals to community resources. Some of our specialty services include infusion therapy, wound care, diabetic management, and rehabilitation.

For Albert Canter, returning to his normal day-to-day routine was at the top of his list. Canter is a vibrant senior who still works six days a week at a deli owned by members of his family. He and Evelyn, his wife of 63 years, share a lovely home in Encino.

One day in January, Canter noticed some swelling in his lower left leg. The ultrasound ordered by his internist, Dr. Richard Walter, showed a blood clot had formed. Since it was the height of flu season and the hospitals were full, it was decided that home healthcare would be Canter's best option for treatment. Dr. Walter referred him to Jewish Home Care Services.

It was then Esther Katz-Willson, RN, director of clinical services for JHCS, joined Canter's

healthcare team. "I visited him twice each day," she explains. "Each time, he received an injection of an anti-coagulate to reduce the clot. I also performed a skilled nursing assessment, which included examination of his leg for swelling, bruising, or rashes. And I checked his vital signs and listened for lung sounds."

In addition to these hands-on services, Esther spoke with Canter about any pain he was experiencing, if any falls had occurred, and how his diet was. "I was there to answer any questions that he or Mrs. Canter may have had," she says.

Reflecting on his JHCS experience, Canter says that he "appreciated being able to receive the treatment I needed right in my own home. The care Esther provided was excellent and more personalized than I would have received in a hospital. She was very accommodating and came at times that were convenient for us."

For Evelyn, having her husband at home was extremely important. "To have him with me and to be able to see how he was doing throughout the day was comforting," she says. "It was also more convenient than driving back and forth to the hospital. Of course, with Al at home it meant that I had to cook more. I'm a little out of practice, but we both survived!"

The experience of providing in-home care is also a positive one for the caregiver. "I love coming into someone's home and becoming a temporary member of the family," Esther says. "It gives me an opportunity to become familiar with the daily routines of patients and their family. You get to know them more personally, much different than in a hospital setting." Also, having the family on hand provides more insight into the patient's activities throughout the day. "I knew I could count on Mrs. Canter to tell me what Mr. Canter was and was not doing!" she says.

After seven days, Canter was back on his feet and ready to go to work. "If you need home health care, you couldn't ask for finer service than I received from Jewish Home Care Services," he affirms. "I've had home care before from other agencies, and the Home's is the best!"

The Sunday evening event was graciously hosted by our Executives President, Ira Halpern at his and wife Susan's home in Encino. What a turn out for a work evening!

We're building a community of Valley donors for now and into the future. We enjoy each other's company and like to think we are



making a difference in the lives of our Jewish Home's seniors and in the community we serve. It's that simple.

The Jewish Home is consistently innovating, evolving, striving to meet the needs of a growing senior population with more complex and diverse needs. 




